**RULES & REGULATIONS AND TERMS OF AGREEMENT FOR
AL-JALAL MASJID RAMADHAN ITIKAAF**

- 1) The Ramadhan itikaaf participants first / earliest entry date to start itikaaf will be on Tuesday 5th June 2018 / 20th Ramadhan 1439 by Maghrib start time / sunset insha'Allah.
- 2) Places are limited up to a maximum of 15 people and priority will be given to regular Masjid attendees; local residents; Masjid volunteers; those who are wishing to do the full 10 days and nights of itikaaf.
- 3) Al-Jalal Masjid will provide sleeping areas, showering, ablution and toilet facilities. Masjid will provide dates and water for suhoor and iftar. You will need to arrange your own additional food to be delivered for suhoor and iftar. Itikaaf participants are required to arrange their own sleeping provisions (pillows, duvet, sleeping bag etc) as well as extra large sheets to cover your itikaaf sleeping cubicle (you will be provided an itikaaf sleeping cubicle insha'Allah).
- 4) You as the itikaaf participant agree to conduct your ibadah (worship) in a dignified quiet manner so that you do not disturb any other participants in itikaaf or worshippers coming into the Masjid.
- 5) On Sunday 10th June, you are required to tidy your belongings by 12.30 pm in the designated area as specified by the Masjid committee in order for the ground floor prayer space to be used for sisters when they came to the Masjid for the Ramadhan Reminder Series 2018. You will not be able to access the ground floor prayer space in the Masjid from 12.45 pm to 3.15 pm approx.
- 6) On the day's of Jumah (Friday) you will have tidy away all of your belongings and itikaaf cubicle into the designated area as specified by a Masjid committee member / Imam. This has to be done by 12.00pm and you will not be able to access the area again until at least 2.45pm approx.
- 6) The 27th night of Ramadhan is the busiest night of the year in the Masjid and more people access the Masjid then at any other time of the year. Please be aware that your sleeping quarters will not be accessible during the night of 27th Ramadhan from after Maghrib start (Monday 11th June) until after Fajr Jamat on the 27th Ramadhan (Tuesday 12th June) and that you are to tidy your belongings away in the assigned designated area.
- 7) You as the itikaaf participant agree when using the different facilities within the Masjid during itikaaf (e.g. ablution area, toilet area, shower area, prayer areas etc), that you as the itikaaf participant will keep it clean and tidy.
- 8) All itikaaf participants should behave in a appropriate Islamic manner.
- 9) In extreme circumstances if the Imam or Masjid committee members feel there is any inappropriate behaviour by the itikaaf participants then they reserve right to dismiss the participant from further participation in itikaaf in the Masjid.
- 10) You agree to hold yourself responsible for any damages or injuries that may be caused during itikaaf.
- 11) You indemnify the Masjid against any damages, injuries etc during your attendance in the itikaaf in Al-Jalal Masjid.
- 12) You fully agree that you are subjected to the rules and regulations of the itikaaf and Al-Jalal Masjid. By you signing the agreement, you agree to adhere to the rules and regulations of the itikaaf and of Al-Jalal Masjid.
- 13) Rules and regulations are subject to change and are at the discretion of the Masjid Management committee.
- 14) One of the aims of Al-Jalal Masjid is for the worshippers using the Masjid, to have a peaceful environment in order for them to do their ibadah (worship) and also to help them attain taqwa, insha'Allah. Al-Jalal Masjid kindly requests that you help us to provide this peaceful environment by observing the rules and regulations of itikaaf and the Masjid. If you have any suggestion (s) / complaint (s), please ensure that it will be made in writing directly to the Masjid Management committee.
